## **ENDEAVOR**

Endeavor is held Monday - Thursday from 4:00 - 6:30 PM at Eisenhower Elementary  
(1460 School St., Indiana, PA 15701)

This site-based program is designed for children and adolescents with an autism spectrum disorder and behavioral and/or communication needs. Endeavor's goal is to help participants increase functional communication, increase independence skills, and decrease problematic behaviors.

The Endeavor program is rooted in Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA), including verbal behavior and behavior modification, as well as independent skills, social skills, and communication. Endeavor also features intensive teaching, natural environment training, and structured games.

Each child has individualized treatment goals, such as functional communication, functional play skills, accepting no, waiting skills, decreasing aggression, decreasing self-injurious behavior, and decreasing elopement. These goals are assessment-based; assessments that we may use include the Functional Behavior Assessment, the VB-MAPP, the Essentials for Living, and the Assessment of Functional Living Skills.

Endeavor is for children and adolescents ages 6-21. It runs at a 1:2 staff to child ratio. A recommendation by a psychologist is required. If needed, a psychological evaluation can be easily coordinated through our office.
